

**Preliminary Notice of Race**  
**C&C Owners Regatta & Rendezvous**  
**June 20<sup>th</sup>, June 30<sup>th</sup>, July 1<sup>st</sup> ,2012**

National Yacht Club, Toronto

1. Organizing Authority: National Yacht Club and the C&C Owners Regatta & Rendezvous Committee.
2. The Regatta will be governed by the rules, as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
3. Classes to race:
  - a. Yachts designed and built by C&C Yachts. It predecessors and successors, and others upon application.
  - b. 2.4 mR yachts
4. Racing will be in spinnaker and white-sail fleets under PHRF Lake Ontario time-on-time handicap scoring and in one design fleets where registration numbers warrant.
5. Handicaps: Boats shall enclose a copy of a current PHRF rating certificate with registration: the race committee will assign arbitrary ratings to boats not providing a valid rating certificate. One-design boats shall have available proof of class membership and current measurement certificates.
6. Location: Racing will be in Lake Ontario, in Humber Bay and South of the Toronto Islands on three separate windward-leeward courses.
7. The Race Committee will establish and publish fleet splits and starting orders on the Official Notice Board before 0900 hours on June 30<sup>th</sup> .
8. Number of Races: The Regatta will consist of a maximum of 5 races. The warning signal each day will be 1100 hours. On Saturday, no warning will be signaled after 1530 hours. On Sunday no warning will be signaled after 1400 hours.
9. Series Scoring: All races will count. This amends RRS A2. Prizes will be given for the first three (3) places in each fleet, in addition to many other goodies.
10. Registration forms are available in PDF format at [www.thenyc.com](http://www.thenyc.com).
11. Early registration is encouraged. The following schedule details fee deadlines. Boats may register at the National Yacht Club on Friday June 29<sup>th</sup> from 1600 to 2100 hours and Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup> from 0730 hours to 0900 hours.
12. Sailing Instructions will be available at National Yacht Club, at the Registration Desk on Friday, and on Saturday Morning.
13. Arbitration. For protests involving infringement of a rule of part 2 RRS, an arbitration hearing may be held prior to the protest hearing.
14. Instructions for Cruising Events will be available at the National Yacht Club on Friday and Saturday. This Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions will not govern cruising events.
