"The objective of the CYA Basic Cruising Standard is for you, on completion, to be able to cruise safely by day in local waters, in moderate wind and sea conditions, as skipper or crew of a 20-30 foot sloop-rigged keelboat."

The full course comprises approximately 30 hours, of which 7-8 hours are in a classroom setting, with the balance "on the water". Courses are taught in our club-owned fleet of keelboats and are designed to give the student extensive time "at the helm".

Testing for the CYA Basic Cruising Standard is in two parts: an **on-the-water test**, during which you demonstrate ability in the Afloat Skills (practical) portion and a **written test** on Ashore Knowledge (theory). When you pass both parts of the examination, you will receive official recognition in the form of your CYA Cruising Logbook which contains the CYA seal and the signature(s) of your evaluating CYA Certified Cruising Instructor.

Upon completion of the CYA Basic Cruising Course a student can improve their sailing skills all summer long by participating in our Crew Banks or the Shark Club. All Club members have the opportunity to use the Crew Bank (free of charge) to go racing (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday) or cruising (Monday or Thursday) as crew aboard Club Members' boats. The Shark Club (additional fee) is a community sailing program within the club that allows its members to cruise or race on club owned boats.

Our fully qualified CYA Instructors teach the full course in a variety of sessions.
